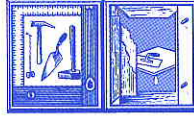

The current language in the collective bargaining agreement reads as follows:

Article XVI - Continued Education Training

Section 1. All training classes will be under the supervision and presentation of the Western Washington Masonry Trades Apprenticeship & Training Trust/Spokane Local 3 Training Trust. **Section 2.** This required journey upgrade course will be eight (8) hours per year. **Section 3.** It is mandatory that all journeyman, foreman, and supervisors complete the eight (8) hour course every year. **Section 4.** Non-completion in the one-year eight (8) hour program may result in the loss of the following year's (on-the-check) raise. NOTE: All benefits as agreed will be paid and credited to the worker's account. The penalty for not receiving certification will not be retroactive and cannot be reinstated for the time of delinquency. Completion warrants raise. **Section 5.** Curriculum for the program will be furnished and certified by a joint effort between Labor / Management and the Western Washington Masonry Trades Apprenticeship & Training Trust / Spokane Local #3 Training Trust. **Section 6.** All the members will participate on their own time. **Section 7.** Labor and Management will work together to provide a curriculum generated by Contractor request.
